



POLICY PURSUANT TO EU REGULATION 2016/679, GDPR

Dear Customer/Supplier,

EU Regulation 2016/679 states that data subjects must be informed in advance regarding the use of data relating to them and that the processing of personal data is only permitted with the express consent of the data subject, except in the cases provided for by law.

Data Controller:

The Data Controller is:

MLTS EUROPA S.R.L., with registered office at Via Tinelli, 55 - 54100 - Massa (MS) - Italy.

Data processing purpose:

Personal data are processed as part of the normal activity of MLTS EUROPA S.R.L. for administrative and accounting purposes:

- fulfilment of tax or accounting obligations;
- customer management;
- supplier management;
- legal, economic and training processing of staff.

Recipients or categories of recipients to whom personal data may be disclosed:

Companies or external parties carrying out activities closely related and instrumental to the management of the business relationship, such as:

- credit institutions;
- consultants and individual and associated professionals.

Rights of the data subject:

The data subject has the right to obtain, from the Data Controller, confirmation as to whether or not personal data relating to him/her are being processed and, in that case, he/she is entitled to:

- obtain access to the personal data, request the rectification or erasure of the personal data or the restriction of the processing of personal data concerning him or her, or to object to the processing of said data;

- receive, in a structured, commonly used format and legible by an automatic device, the personal data concerning him/her from the Data Controller and to forward said data to another data controller (i.e., right of portability);
- be informed of the existence of an automated decision-making process, including profiling;
- if expressly provided for, withdraw consent at any time, notwithstanding the lawfulness of the processing based on the consent given before the withdrawal;
- complain to the supervisory authority.

Nature of the data and consequences of non-disclosure:

Without the processing and communication of data of a compulsory nature for the described purposes, it will not be possible to provide the individual concerned with the services and/or products requested, either in whole or in part.
